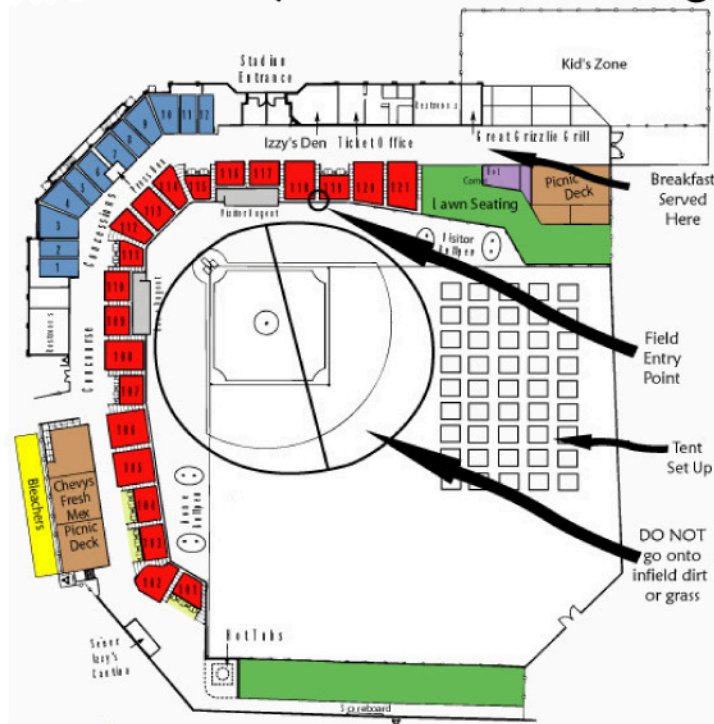


Field set-up:

Yes, you can. Please call (618) 337-3000 x22 to make special arrangements.

Will there be concession stands open during the sleepover?

The concession stands will not be open for the sleepover; however, the vending machines will be available for the purchase of drinks. Feel free to bring store-bought, unopened snacks and bottled water/soft drinks (but **NO COOLERS**) for after the game; however, no outside food will be permitted into the stadium at any time. Complimentary popcorn or a pretzel and soft drink or water will be available during the post-game entertainment. You will receive a voucher for your snack.

Will there be restrooms open during the sleepover?

Yes, the restrooms on the first and third base side of the main concourse will remain open for the entire night. The family restrooms behind home plate will also be available.

How do I get to GCS Ballpark?

Take I-255 to Mousette Lane (Exit 15). West at stop sign onto Sauget Industrial Park Drive, then left at stop sign onto Goose Lake Road. The ballpark will be on the right.
